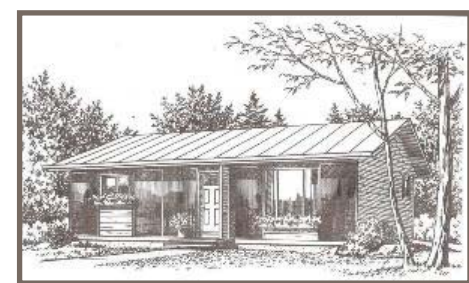
CMHC's EQUilibrium Initiative

- Facilitating public demonstrations, performance monitoring and reporting.



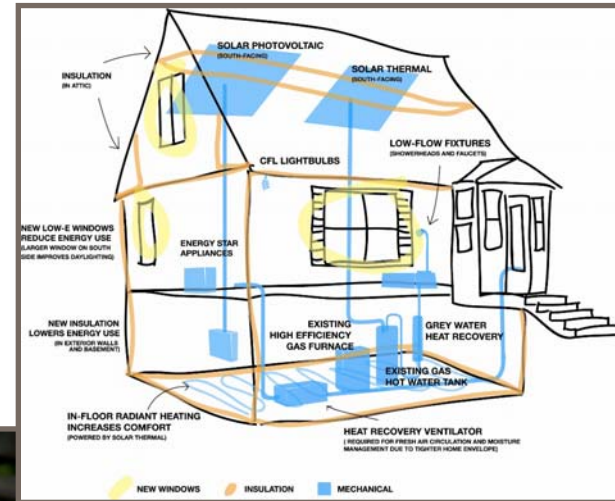
