

Statistical Information Guidelines 2009

Line #	Description
2101	Report how many RGI households with incomes at or below the HILs that were assisted by each program at the end of the year. Note: There is no ongoing assistance associated with the limited dividend and section 26 and 27 programs. Therefore, there are no targeted households in these programs.
2105	Report how many households (RGI and non-RGI) with incomes above the HILs that were assisted by each program at the end of the year. Note: There is no ongoing assistance associated with the limited dividend and section 26 and 27 programs. Therefore, no households would be assisted.
2106	Report the total number of vacant units at year-end in order to fully account for all units under administration.
2111	Report the total number of RGI units occupied by families in receipt of geared-to-income assistance that are at or below the HILs.
2113	Report the average (annual) income of the families occupying units reported in line 2111 (where geared-to-income assistance was received).
2115	Report the total number of non-targeted family households (RGI and non-RGI) surveyed that have incomes above the HILs.
2121	Report the total number of RGI units occupied by senior citizens (aged 55+ as reflected in our local mandate) in receipt of geared-to-income assistance that are at or below the HILs.
2123	Report the average (annual) income of the senior citizens (aged 55+ as reflected in our local mandate) occupying units reported in line 2121 (where geared-to-income assistance was received).
2125	Report the total number of non-targeted senior citizens (aged 55+ as reflected in our local mandate) households (RGI and non-RGI) surveyed that have incomes above the HILs.
2131	Report the total number of RGI units occupied by non-elderly single persons in receipt of geared-to-income assistance that are at or below the HILs.
2133	Report the average (annual) income of the non-elderly single persons occupying units reported in line 2131 (where geared-to-income assistance was received).
2135	Report the total number of non-targeted non-elderly single persons (RGI and non-RGI) surveyed that have incomes above the HILs.
2141	Report the total number of RGI units occupied by special needs households (care or support services) in receipt of geared-to-income assistance that are at or below the HILs.
2143	Report the average (annual) income of the special needs households occupying units reported in line 2141 (where geared-to-income assistance was received).
2145	Report the total number of non-targeted special needs households (RGI and non-RGI) surveyed that have incomes above the HILs.
2151	Enter the same number as line 2101.
2152	Report the portion of line 2151 that were high need households.
2153	This information is meant to confirm the number of units in the portfolio that have been modified for tenants with disabilities.
2154	Households receiving support services from the Ministry of Community and Social Services or Ministry of Health and Long Term Care.
